



**Figure 4 - Childs 5 School Sweater Sleeve**

**Figure 2 - Childs 5 School Sweater**


**AMOUNT OF YARN REQUIRED TO MAKE GARMENT: --- WARNING.**  
**THIS IS A ROUGH ESTIMATE ONLY.** Measure a sample piece for a more accurate calculation. Amount needed:

7.1 for body and sleeves  
1.0 for ribbing and/or hems  
0.2 for collar/hood  
8.3 Ounces TOTAL

**NOTES:** 4 Ply Knitting worsted weight; machine washable and dryable; 80% acrylic and 20% wool.; 3oz/85gr; 197 yards/180meters

5. At the same time, when armhole measures 6.0 ins (row 36), start shoulder shaping.
6. Shoulder shaping. Cast off 7 sts at armhole edge twice.

**FRONT:**

- 1-2 Follow steps 1 and 2 as for back.
3. Armhole. Dec for armhole at both ends, as for back. Continue until armhole measures 1.7 ins (10 rows), with 55 sts remaining.
4. Divide for neck. Work both sides at the same time. Work 27 sts. With a second ball of yarn, cast off next 1 sts and work remaining 27 sts.
5. Shape neck. Dec 1 st at neck edge of next row, then every 2nd row 12 times, until 14 sts remain.
6. Work even until armhole measures 6.0 ins (36 rows).
7. Shoulder shaping. Cast off as for back.

**SLEEVES:**

1. Cast on 34 sts on size 6 needles. Work in K1P1 ribbing for 1.3 ins. Inc 3 sts evenly across the row to 37 sts total.
2. Change to size 8 needles and Stocking stitch.
3. Inc 1 st at each end of every 9th row 3 times, then every 10th row twice to 47 sts (47 rows total, excluding hem).
4. Work even until sleeve measures 9.2 ins (56 rows), excluding hem.
5. Shape cap. Cast off 3 sts at beg of next two rows (41 sts rem). Dec 1 st at each end of every row once, then dec 1 st at each end of every 2nd row 12 times, then dec 1 st at each end of every row once. Cast off remaining 13 sts loosely.

**SHOULDER SEAMS:**

1. Sew fronts to back along shoulder seams.

**V FRONT NECK SINGLE BAND COLLAR:**

- by hand on size 6 needles. Worked in 2 pieces.
1. With right side of work facing, pick up and work (starting at bottom of front neck) 25 sts from right front neck edge, 2 sts from right back neck edge and 11 sts from back neck holder to center. Total 38 sts.
  2. Work 0.8 ins (6 rows) in K1P1 ribbing centering stripe on these rows.
  3. Cast off loosely.
  4. Work the left side the same way as the right, picking up the back neck sts first.

**FINISHING:**

1. Sew sleeve top to armhole, easing to fit. Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew any remaining seams.
2. Darn/weave/sew in all loose ends.

## Child's Size 5 Wizard School

Regular length Straight Pullover sweater with ribbing at bottom.  
Classic set-in armhole with full length tapered sleeves with ribbed cuff.  
V-front neckline and shallow back neck with single layer neckband.

School Sweater Child 5 [24" bust measurement]

**YARN:** Lion Brand Wool Ease Worsted; 80% acrylic/20% wool; machine wash and dry.

**GAUGE:** Gauge (Stocking stitch over 4 in = 10 cm): 18.0 sts by 24.0 rows.  
Body knit on # 8 US needles  
Ribbing knit on # 6 US needles

**FINISHED measurements** in inches: with a "growing room" fit.

Bust/Chest: 27.3"	Back Neck Width: 5.0"
Total Armhole: 11.6"	Back Width: 11.7"
Top Neck Opening: 5.9"	Sleeve Length: 10.5"
Hem Width: 7.0"	Back Neck Depth: 0.4"
Front Neck Width: 0.3"	Body Length: 15.6"
Sleeve Top: 10.3"	Hem Length: 1.3"
V-Neck Depth: 5.0"	Neckband Depth: 0.8"
Hem Width: 27.3"	Hem Length: 1.8"
Sleeve Bottom: 7.7"	

**Note:** Read ALL these instructions thoroughly BEFORE starting to knit.  
There may be sections where there are two shapings to work at the same time (such as necklines or waist shaping).

At this gauge, and particularly on a Child's size vest, a 1/1/1 stripe sequence is .66" wide. A wider stripe [such as a 1/2/1 row sequence] would be out of proportion but the choice is up to the knitter.

**BACK:**

1. Cast on 63 sts on size 6 needles. Work in K1P1 ribbing for 1.8 ins.
2. Change to size 8 needles and Stocking stitch. Knit 1 or 2 rows in main color then begin stripe pattern. Continue in main color. Work even until piece measures 7.3 ins (44 rows), excluding hem.
3. Armhole shaping. Cast off 3 sts at beginning of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at each end of every alternate row for 2 rows until 55 sts remaining. Continue until armhole measures 6.0 ins (36 rows), with 55 sts remaining.
4. Shape neck. Work both sides at the same time. Work 16 sts. Slip the next 23 sts to a holder. With a second ball of yarn, work remaining 16 sts. Dec 1 st at neck edge every row twice, until 14 sts remain.
