

WIZARD SCHOOL VEST

Standard length pullover vest with ribbed edges along bottom, arm-bands and neckband.
Classic armhole shaping trimmed with ribbing.

V-neck front and shallow back neck are also trimmed with 1 x 1 ribbing.

Misses' Size 10 Wizard School Vest

Size: Standard Woman 32 for Wizard Student

MATERIALS: Patons# Classic Merino Wool; #0225 or black for "PoA"; 100% wool; Hand wash;
Lay flat to dry.

STITCH & ROW GAUGE: Gauge for stocking stitch over 4 inches = 10 cm: 20 stitches x 26 rows.

Body knit on US #7 needles; Ribbing knit on US #5 needles.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS in inches ... with "average" fit:

- Finished Chest: 34 ¼"
- Total Armhole: 15 ½"
- Hem Width: 15.8
- Width at point of "V": 1/3"
- V-Neck Depth: 7"
- Ribbed Hem Width: 33"
- Neckband/armband depth: 1.1"
- Back Shoulder Width: 13"
- Back Neck Depth: ½"
- Vest Body Length: 22"
- Collar Length: 1.1"
- Ribbed Hem depth: 2 ½"

Note: Be sure to read ALL the instructions completely BEFORE you begin to knit. There may be sections where two sets of instructions are given. They are to be worked at the same time (such as necklines and shoulders).

BACK:

1. Cast on 84 stitches on size 5 needles. Work in K1P1 ribbing for 2.5 inches. Increase 4 stitches evenly across the row to 88 stitches total.
2. Change to size 7 needles and Stocking stitch. Work even until piece measures 10.2 inches (66 rows), excluding hem.
3. Begin armhole shaping: Cast off 10 stitches at beginning of next 2 rows. Dec 1 stitches at each end of every alternate row for 12 rows until 56 stitches remaining. Continue until armhole measures 8.9 inches (58 rows), with 56 stitches remaining.
4. Shape neck. Work both sides at the same time. Work 16 stitches. Slip the next 24 stitches to a holder. With a second ball of yarn, work remaining 16 stitches. Dec 1 stitches at neck edge every row 3 times, until 13 stitches remain.
5. At the same time, when armhole measures 8.9 ins (row 58), start shoulder shaping.
6. Shoulder shaping. Cast off 6 stitches at armhole edge, then cast off 7 stitches at armhole edge.

FRONT:

- 1-2 Follow steps 1 and 2 as for back.
3. Begin armhole shaping: Decrease for armhole at both ends, as for back. Continue until armhole measures 2.5 inches (16 rows), with 56 stitches remaining.
4. Divide for neck: **Work both sides at the same time.** Work 28 stitches. With a second ball of yarn, work remaining 28 stitches.

5. Shape neck. Dec 1 stitch at neck edge of next row, then every 2nd row twice, then every 3rd row 12 times, until 13 stitches remain.
6. Work even until armhole measures 8.9 inches (58 rows).
7. Shoulder shaping. Cast off as for back.

SHOULDER SEAMS:

1. Sew fronts to back along shoulder seams.

V-FRONT NECKBAND:

Knit on smaller #5 needles **and** in 2 pieces.

1. With right side of work facing, pick up and work (starting at bottom of front neck) 37 stitches from right front neck edge, 3 stitches from right back neck edge and 12 stitches from back neck holder to center. You have a total 52 stitches.
2. Work 1.1 inches (8 rows) in K1P1 ribbing.
3. Cast off loosely.
4. Work the left side the same way as the right, picking up the back neck stitches first.

ARMHOLE RIBBING:

Knit on smaller #5 needles

1. With right side of work facing, pick up and work 130 stitches along armhole edge between side seams by picking up one stitch for every armhole cast-off stitch and one for every row.
2. Decrease from 130 to 97 by: P 16, P2tog *(P 1 P2tog)* 32 times P 16
3. Work in K1P1 ribbing for 0.8 inches (approx 6 rows). Cast off loosely.

FINISHING & Assembly:

1. Sew side seams. Sew any remaining seams.
2. Darn/weave/sew in all loose ends.

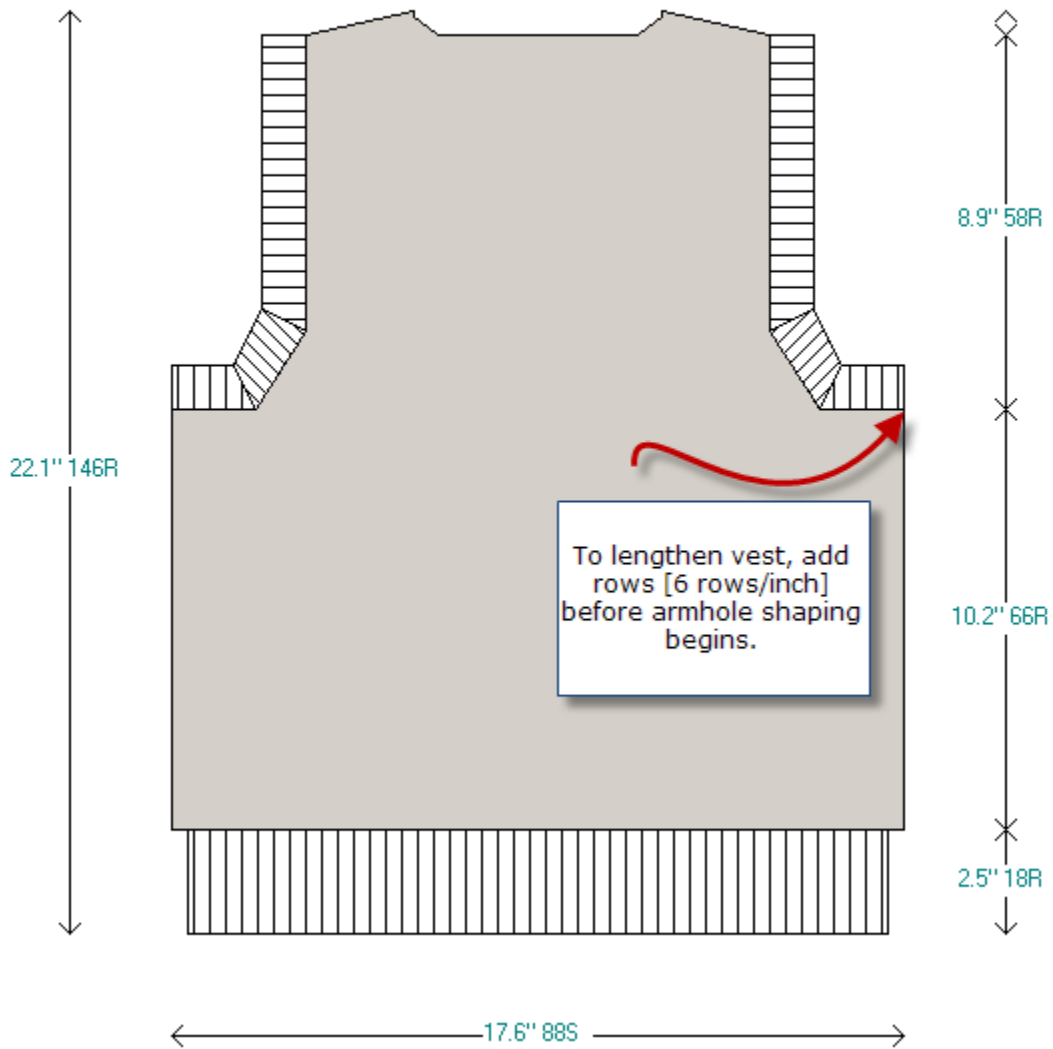
YARN REQUIRED: 10 ounces [3 skeins] + 1 each of the House colors.

NOTES:

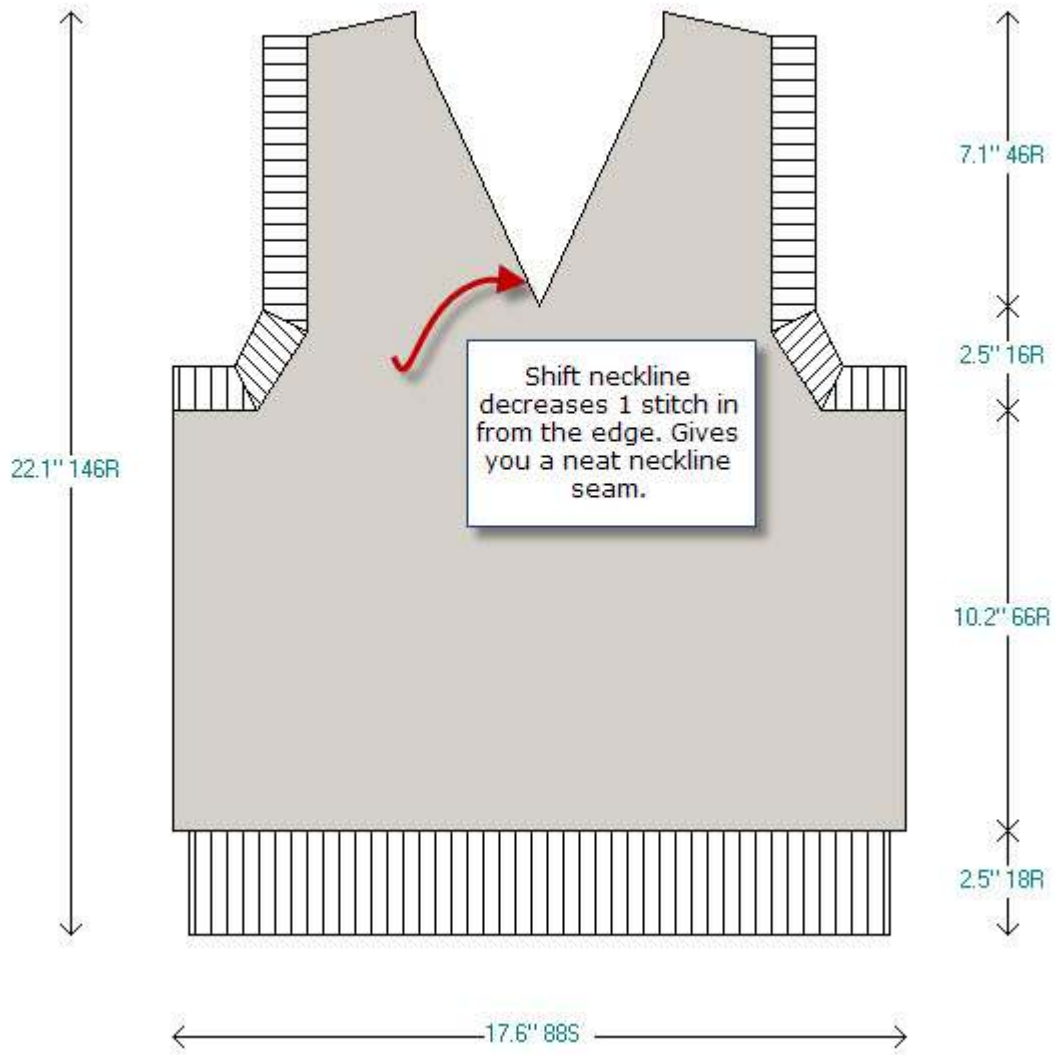
House colors of your choice - 1 skein of each color is more than sufficient.

House stripe near bottom of vest and in v-neckband. Armbands are solid colored.
